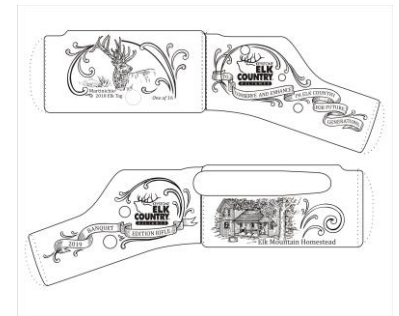
Greetings, Ladies and Gentlemen:
